- SBV was granted 'Deemed University' status by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under section 3 of the UGC Act of 1956 in 2008, in recognition of its outstanding quality of providing education, potential for excellence and obtained NAAC"A" Grade in 2015, with CGPA of 3.11 on 4 point scale.
- SBV has been placed in the top 100 for three consecutive years 2016, 2017 & 2018 at the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) and is in the top 25 among the Medical colleges through its flagship institute, namely Mahatma Gandhi Medical College & Research Institute.

Introduction of the course

Course Title: Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support (ACLS) Provider Course

Duration: Two Days (9 am to 4 pm) (+2 hrs self study/day)

(Students who intend to take this course have to register at least 3 weeks before the course date. A pre-course preparation of at least 3 weeks using the ACLS student manual is recommended before participating in the course).

Course description and goal:

The Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support (ACLS) Provider Course is designed for healthcare providers who either direct or participate in the management of cardiopulmonary arrest or other cardiovascular emergencies.

Through didactic instruction and active participation in simulated cases, the students will enhance their skills and clinical decision-making abilities for the diagnosis and treatment of cardiopulmonary arrest, acute arrhythmia, stroke and acute coronary syndromes. Students are taught to use the following important concepts:

Basic Life Support (BLS) Survey
High-quality cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
ACLS Survey
ACLS algorithms
Effective resuscitation team dynamics
Immediate post-cardiac arrest care

The goal of the ACLS Provider Course is to improve outcomes for adult patients with cardiac arrest and other cardiopulmonary emergencies through provider training.

Course objectives:

Upon successful completion of this course, the student will

- Recognize and initiate early management of peri-arrest conditions that my result in cardiac arrest or complicate resuscitation outcome.
- Demonstrate proficiency in providing BLS care, including prioritizing chest compressions and integrating use of an automated external defibrillator (AED)
- Recognize and manage respiratory arrest
- Recognize and manage cardiac arrest until termination of resuscitation or transfer of care, including immediate post-cardiac arrest care.
- Recognize and initiate early management of acute coronary syndromes (ACS), including appropriate disposition
- Recognize and initiate early management of stroke, including appropriate disposition
- Demonstrate effective communication as a member or leader of a resuscitation learn and recognize the impact of team dynamics on overall team performance.

Faculty: ACLS Provider Course is taught by MGMCRI faculty who are AHA certified instructors. There are 17 AHA accredited ACLS Instructors aligned with MGMCRI.

Number of seats: 12 students are admitted to each course. One ACLS course is held every month. In addition, all Postgraduate resident doctors of MGMCRI undergo mandatory training in ACLS.

Eligibility criteria for students: ACLS is designed for healthcare professionals who either direct or participate in the management of cardiopulmonary arrest and other cardiovascular emergencies. This includes personnel in emergency response, emergency medicine, intensive care and critical care units.

Course content:

The ACLS Provider Course emphasizes 3 major concepts:

- The crucial importance of high-quality CPR to patient survival
- The integration of effective BLS with ACLS interventions
- The importance of effective team interaction and communication during resuscitation

The course content includes

- Airway management
- Basic life support skills, including effective chest compressions, use of a bag-mask device & use of an AED
- Effective communication as a member and leader of a resuscitation team
- Effective Resuscitation Team Dynamics
- Key changes in advanced cardiovascular life support, reflecting the 2010 American Heart
- Association Guidelines for Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and Emergency Cardiovascular Care
- Management of acute coronary syndromes (ACS) and stroke
- Recognition and early management of peri-arrest conditions such as symptomatic bradycardia
- Recognition and early management of respiratory and cardiac arrest
- Related pharmacology

The course is designed to give students the opportunity to practice and demonstrate proficiency in the following skills used in resuscitation:

- ➤ BLS and ACLS surveys
- CPR and AED
- Airway Management
- > Rhythm recognition
- Defibrillation
- > Use of medications
- > Cardioversion
- > Transcutaneous pacing
- > Team resuscitation concept (team leader and team member)
- Post-cardiac arrest care

Teaching Methodology:

- The students are taught using an Instructional DVD with students practicing skills while watching the Instructional video.
- The high point of the ACLS Provider Course is that students learn the Megacode Team Resuscitation approach to cardiac arrest, post-cardiac and peri-cardiac arrest care on advanced High-Fidelity simulator manikins.

The student: manikin ratio for CPR and Airway Management is 3:1

The student: manikin ratio for Megacode Team Resuscitation on High-Fidelity manikins is 6:1

Evaluation and Course Completion Requirements:

To complete the ACLS Provider course successfully and to be eligible to receive the AHA ACLS Course completion card, a student must

- 1. Pass the 1-Rescuer CPR and AED Test
- 2. Pass the 1-Rescuer bag-mask ventilation Test
- 3. Demonstrate competency in all learning station skills
- 4. Pass the Megacode Test

Pass the Written Exam with a score of at least 42 out 50 (84%) Multiple Choice Questions
